Notice of Race

1. Rules

The race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 published by the Hong Kong Sailing Federation (the RRS), The Aberdeen Boat Club Standard Sailing Instruction (the SSI) and Classic Yacht Rally 2011 Sailing Instructions (the SI) copies of which may be downloaded from the Club's website www.abclubhk.com from Friday 30 April.

2. Advertising

The advertising category for the race is Category C.

3. Eligibility and entry

Open to all boats with valid HKPN or IRC rating or as otherwise agreed by the race committee.

No dinghy or multihull without accommodation will be ranked as a starters unless all persons on board are wearing personal buoyancy as specified in their class rules.

4. Divisions

Division 1: Classic Racing Yachts

(built more than 21 years ago)

Division 2: Classic Cruising Yachts

(built more than 21 years ago)

Division 3: Non-Classic Racing A and B

Division 4: Non-Classic Cruising

Division 5: Motoring A for motor boats

Division 6: Motoring B for sailing boats

For Divisions 1 and 2, subject to numbers, classes may be constituted as follows for the Concours D' Elegance.

Classic Class – design year 21-40 years ago,

Vintage Class – design year 41-60 years ago

Antique Class – design year >61 years ago

5. Fees

Dinghy entry fee will be \$50

Classic Sailing and Motor Boat \$100

Non-classic sailing and motor boat \$150

Dinner on Saturday \$150

Breakfast on Sunday \$50

Prize giving BBQ party \$120

6. Schedule & venue

Boats may race on both days or choose to race on one day and cruise on the other.

Boats may choose to switch to motoring division at any time during the race by informing the race officer.

Saturday 7 May, one race or rally at 15:00, from Stanley Bay to Tai Tam Bay according to the SI.

Saturday 7 May, overnight and dinner at the Hobie Club in Tai Tam.

Sunday 8 May, breakfast, one race at 10:00 am, back to Deep Water Bay, or a treasurer hunt according to the SI.

Sunday 8 May, Concours d' Elegance and prize giving at Middle Island.

7. Sailing instructions

SI will be available on the ABC website on Friday 30 April at 17:00.

8. Courses

Will be detailed in the SI.

9. Penalty system

According to rule 44 of the RRS 2009-2012.

10. Berthing

A limited number of mooring facilities will be available upon early entry to the race.

11. Prizes

Prizes shall be awarded on Sunday at the ABC Middle Island club house after racing.

12. Disclaimer of liability

Competitors participate in the racing entirely at their own risk. The Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the racing.
