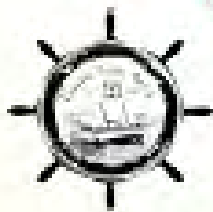

# Classic Yacht Rally

**25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> April 2015**

## **1. Rules**

The Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 - 2016. The Aberdeen Boat Club Standard Sailing Instruction 2013 (the SSI) and Classic Yacht Rally 2015 Sailing Instructions (the SI) copies of which may be downloaded from the Club's website [www.abclubhk.com](http://www.abclubhk.com) as of Friday 17 April 2015 by 18:00.

## **2. Advertising**

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

## **3. Eligibility and entry**

Open to all boats with valid HKPN handicap or as otherwise agreed by the race committee.

No dinghy or multihull without accommodation will be ranked as a starter unless all persons on board are wearing personal buoyancy as specified in their class rules.

## **4. Divisions & Classes**

- Division 1 A:** Classic Racing Yachts built more than 25 years ago with HKPN of 1050 or less.
- Division 1 B :** Classic Cruising Yachts built more than 25 years ago with HKPN of 1051 or more.
- Division 2 A:** Non - Classic Racing Yachts with HKPN of 980 or less.
- Division 2 B :** Non - Classic cruising Yachts with HKPN of 981 or more.
- Division 4:** Modern Yachts with a classic design and a valid HKPN.
- Division 5:** Classic Motor boat
- Division 6:** Dinghies

The rally and the Greek party upon booking is open to all non-racing boats following the course only.

**For the purpose of the “Concours D’ Elegance”.**

Divisions 1A, 1B, 4 and 5 subject to entries, shall be constituted as follow:

Classy Class – Design year less than 25 years old, (Division 4 & 5)

Classic Class – design year 25-45 years old, (Division 1A & 1B)

Vintage Class – design year 46-65 years old, (Division 1A & 1B)

Antique Class – design year >65 years old, (Division 1A & 1B)

**For the purpose of results and “Concours D’ Elegance”:**

Design Class could be considered if there are more than three entries per type for:

Taipan, Cape Carib, Various Cheoy Lee, Flying Fifteen, Dragons, Sonata, Ruffian and Impala.

## 5. Entry Fees

Classic Sailing and Motor Boat \$200

Non - classic sailing and motor boat \$250

Dinghy entry fee will be \$100

## 6. Schedule

Boats may race, according to SI, on both days or choose to race only one day.
