



# LADIES HELM 2014 Notice of Race

## 1. RULES

The race will be governed by the rules as defined in:

- a. The Notice of Race (NOR).
- b. The Aberdeen Boat Club Standard Sailing Instructions. (SSI)
- c. The Aberdeen Boat Club Ladies Helm Annexe G.1 page 44 (SSI)
- d. In case of conflict between any of the above, succeeding items take precedence.

The Organizing Authority is  
the Aberdeen Boat Club.



## 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

- a. The series is opened to all Cruisers and multihulls holding a valid IRC and / or HKPN rating.
- b. The Skippers of Co-owned or Club owned J80 must declare their name to the Organising Authority before each race.
- c. Entrants should notify the Sailing Secretary at [sailingsecretary@abclubhk.com](mailto:sailingsecretary@abclubhk.com) or register on line under the race web-page:

d. Late boats wishing to enter should inform the Committee Boat at the line and if possible on VHF Channel 72 no later than 11 minutes before the first warning signal.

e. Entries on the day of racing may be accepted at the discretion of the race Officer.

f. Entry fees for the race will be HK\$ 150 .

- a. IRC Division: Keelboats with valid IRC certificates.
- b. HKPN Division: according to HKPN rating system.
- c. J/80s
