DEPARTURE PORT CLEARANCE

- 1. A Port Clearance should be obtained before a yacht/pleasure vessel leaves Hong Kong waters.
- 2. The yachtmasters/owners/agents should produce a General Declaration Form M.O.618A together with the Certificate of Registry and a Sailing Notice at one of the District Marine Offices.
- 3. A prescribed fee of HK\$58 is charged for the issue of a port clearance.
- 4. The port clearance ceases to be valid after the lapse of 72 hours.
- 5. The yachtmasters/owners/agents are required to re-apply for a port clearance if the intended departure is deferred for more than 72 hours after the port clearance is issued, or inform the District Marine Office if the intended departure is cancelled.
