F. Thienpont, Pins des Dunes Blanc, Bordeaux 2022 – Bordeaux, France "Sliced pears, grapefruit and gooseberries on the nose. Bright and sleek with a medium body, lightly waxy texture and a pure, refreshing finish. 100% sauvignon blanc." - James Suckling. (JS 90)	\$128		
Dr. Loosen, Blue Slate Riesling Kabinett 2023 – Mosel, Germany Kabinett is the lightest, most delicate style of Riesling in Germany, produced from the earliest harvested grapes in the best vineyard sites. Fermentation is stopped by chilling, which results in a moderate amount of residual sweetness that beautifully balances the bright acidity.	\$165		
Tournon by M Chapoutier, Landsborough Vineyard Viognier 2017 – Victoria, Australia "Varietal, candied apricots with a smooth, ripe and fleshy texture to the palate." - James Suckling (JS 90)	\$198

Bouchard Pere & Fils, Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2021 – Burgundy, France Elegant small fruit flavours. A pleasantly balanced wine which reveals a harmonious blend of fruit and terroir. To enjoy young for its freshness.	\$235		
Chateau Peymouton, Saint Emilion Grand Cru 2018 –Bordeaux, France "Raspberries and blueberries, as well as herbal and earthy notes. Medium-bodied with dusty tannins. Savory and quite firm. Clean finish. Slightly lean." - James Suckling. (JS 89)	\$225		
Sarget de Gruaud Larose, St Julien 2019 – Bordeaux, France "The 2019 Sarget de Gruaud-Larose has a well-defined bouquet with tertiary red berry fruit, understated initially but gaining intensity with aeration. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy black fruit, quite tarry with a fair proportion of tobacco and black pepper on the finish. There is quite a lot going on in this wine and it should age well in bottle." - Neal Martin (VNS89)	\$365		
La Rioja Alta, Vina Ardanza Reserva 2016– La Rioja, Spain " Savory and complex with dried orange peel, cedar and plenty of sweet spices, walnuts, caramel, and dried mushrooms. Shows maturity here, with a medium body and superb freshness. Incredibly long finish with lots of truffle and walnut. Lasts over a minute.
