## COVID 19 NEW REGULATIONS AND RELAXATION OF SOME RESTRICTIONS

Dear Members,

You certainly have heard the good news that as of Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> February, if the new cases of COVID 19 keep on reducing Hong Kong will enjoy finally a return to near normality.

Indeed, restaurant will be permitted to open until 10pm with four people per tables.

Gathering of people will also increase to four and many new sporting and recreation facilities will re-open.

We are now waiting for the official gazette to give details of what will be allowed to re-open or not but we have now plenty of hopes as we are going in the right direction.

Nevertheless with more liberty comes more responsibilities and what is now sure is that testing and following people movement will become mandatory.

For instance all staff will have to be tested for COVID 19 every 14 days from the 18<sup>th</sup> February onward and record kept by the Club for inspection by the authorities.

Also a new mandatory policy to use the "Leave Home Safe" application to track your visits in various places and inform you directly if you may have been in contact with virus infected premises.

For those who do not have smart phone or do not wish to use the Apps for whichever reason a mandatory register of your visit, when you come in and leave us, will need to be recorded manually at the club entrances. A special registration book will be available. Please do help us to comply with this as failing to provide such registration form the club will be sanctioned by a HK\$ 50,000 fine and six month imprisonment (for me). This is as serious the government is about this.

Further final information will be sent to you in due time but I am just giving you some heads-up for what is coming up after Chinese New Year

Lots of hopes and a slow return to normal life.
