ABC Hong Kong Four Peaks Race

Race Announcement.

1. A race, to be called the ABC Hong Kong Four Peaks Race, will be held for the first time in 1985 and annually thereafter.
2. The 1985 ABC Hong Kong Four Peaks Race will be held over the weekend of January 26th and 27th, 1985.
3. The start will be from a line laid in Junk Bay on Saturday, 26th January 1985, at 1400 hrs.
4. The course:
 - 4.1.1 start line - Tathong Pt. (port) - Steep Is. (port) - Trio Is. (port) - Table Is. (port) - Shelter Is. (port) - Port Shelter - Ma On Shan summit.
 - 4.1.2 Port Shelter - Ninepins (stbd) - Waglan Is. (stbd) - Po Toi Is. (stbd) - Lamma Is. (port) - Datum Rock (port) - Cheung Chau (stbd) - Shek Kwu Chau (stbd) - Lantau Is. - Lantau Peak.
 - 4.1.3 Lantau Is. - Shek Kwu Chau (port) - Cheung Chau (port) - Lamma Is. - Mt. Senhouse.
 - 4.1.4 Lamma Is. - Lamma Is. (port) - Repulse Bay - Violet Hill - Repulse Bay - ABC finish (off Chung Hom Kok).
- 4.2 In Port Shelter, Hebe Haven and Shelter Cove are out of bounds.
- 4.3 Distances:
 - 4.3.1 Sea: 77 i.n.m.
 - 4.3.2 Land: 17 m.
 - 4.3.3 Height: 8250 feet (approx.)
 - 4.3.4 Land distance by Naismith's rule: 23 m.
5. There will be no handicapping system. Prizes will be awarded on elapsed time by class.
6. Classes:

There will be five classes: Class 1 -- PYS No. 90 and below
Class 2 -- PYS Nos. 91 - 100
Class 3 -- PYS Nos. 101 - 110
Class 4 -- PYS Nos. 111 - 120
Class 5 -- PYS Nos. 120 and above.
7. Prizes:

There will be prizes for each class. Up to three prizes per class will be awarded depending on numbers in each class. There will be a prize for the first yacht to finish.
8. Motive power will be only by: Sail (including coming to and weighing anchor);
Foot when on shore (i.e. walking and running only);
Oar, sail, or swimming (transferring ship to shore and shore to ship).
9. Each crew member must complete at least one peak. Routes up and down peaks and anchorages for access to peaks are a tactical problem for skipper & crew.
10. Entering:
 - 10.1 Entries will be accepted as from 1st December, 1984.
 - 10.2 Entry forms will be available from 26th November, 1984 from: The Manager, Aberdeen Boat Club, Shum Wan Road, Aberdeen.
 - 10.3 General Instructions and Sailing and Hill Climbing Instructions will be available as from 10th December, 1984.
11. Eligibility:
 - 11.1 Any yacht measuring 18 feet LWL or greater is eligible to enter.
 - 11.2 All entrants must comply with ORC Category 4 safety requirements including Cruiser Owner Association additions as per COA Handbook.
 - 11.3 All yachts must provide a 1984/85 ABC PYS No. or be prepared to accept any such number as decided upon by the Race Committee.
