

MARINE DEPARTMENT NOTICE NO. 185/2023

(Marine Works)

Marine Archaeological Survey off Aberdeen South Typhoon Shelter

With immediate effect and for a period of approximately two weeks, marine archaeological survey will be carried out within the area bounded by straight lines joining the following co-ordinates (WGS 84 Datum) from (A) to (F) and the adjacent shoreline:

(A)	22° 13.971'N	114° 10.007'E
(B)	22° 13.885'N	114° 09.933'E
(C)	22° 13.885'N	114° 09.846'E
(D)	22° 14.099'N	114° 09.851'E
(E)	22° 14.131'N	114° 09.900'E
(F)	22° 14.131'N	114° 10.030'E

2. The works will be carried out by one launch. Two work boats will provide assistance. Vessels engaged in the works will display signals as prescribed in international and local regulations.

3. A working area of approximately 20 metres around the launch will be established. Yellow marker buoys fitted with yellow flashing lights will be laid to mark the positions of the anchors extending from the launch.

4. The hours of work will be from 0800 to 1800 hours. No works will be carried out on Sundays and public holidays. Vessels employed for the works will not stay in the works area outside the hours of work.

5. Diving operations will be carried out from time to time during the hours of work.

6. Vessels navigating in the vicinity should proceed with caution and keep clear of the works area at slow speed, bearing in mind that there are divers working in the area.

7. A drawing showing the works area is attached to this Notice.

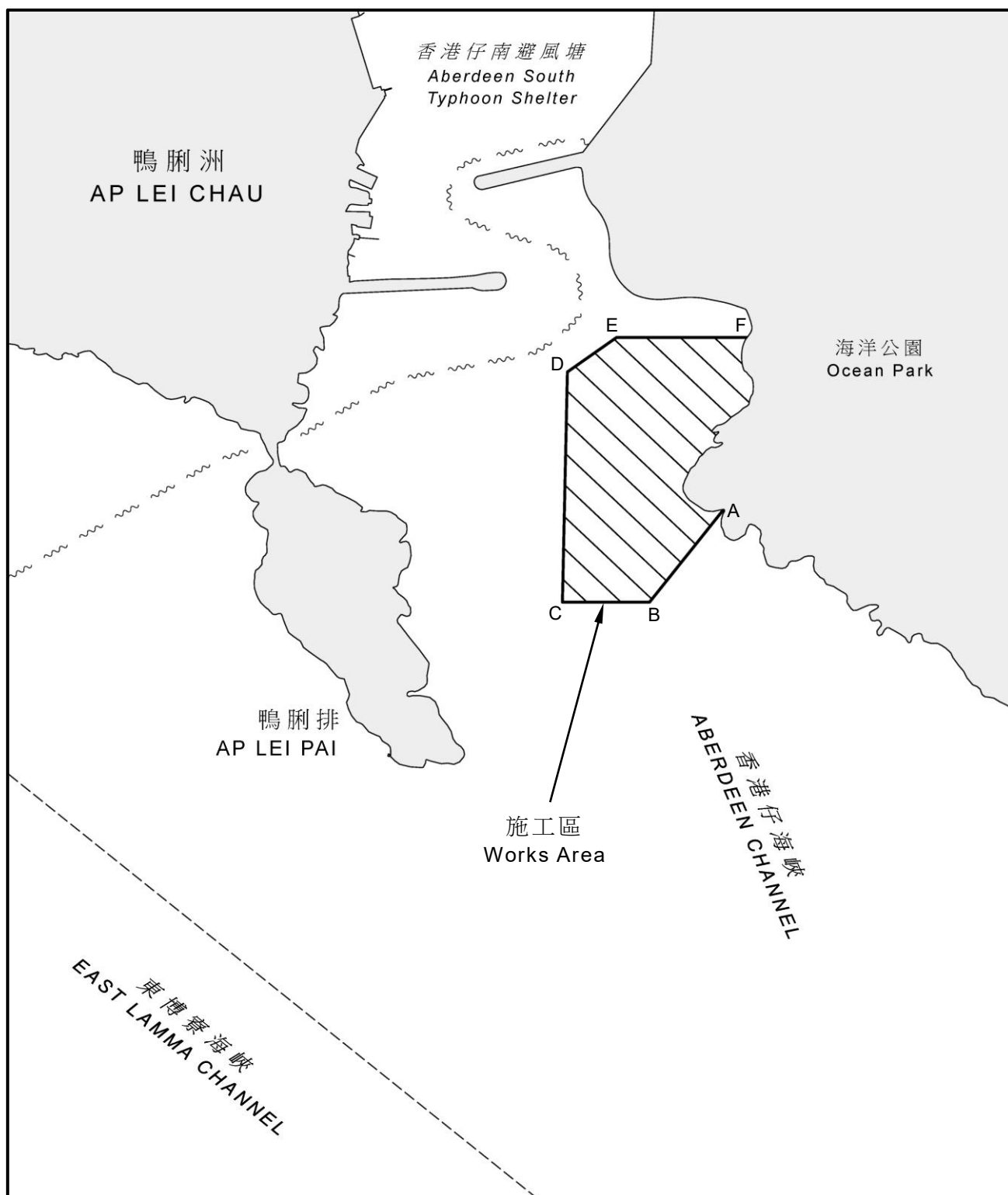
